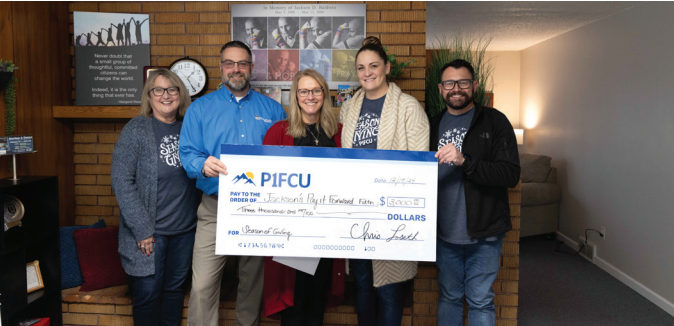
## Head Start Financial Literacy Class

## Season of Giving

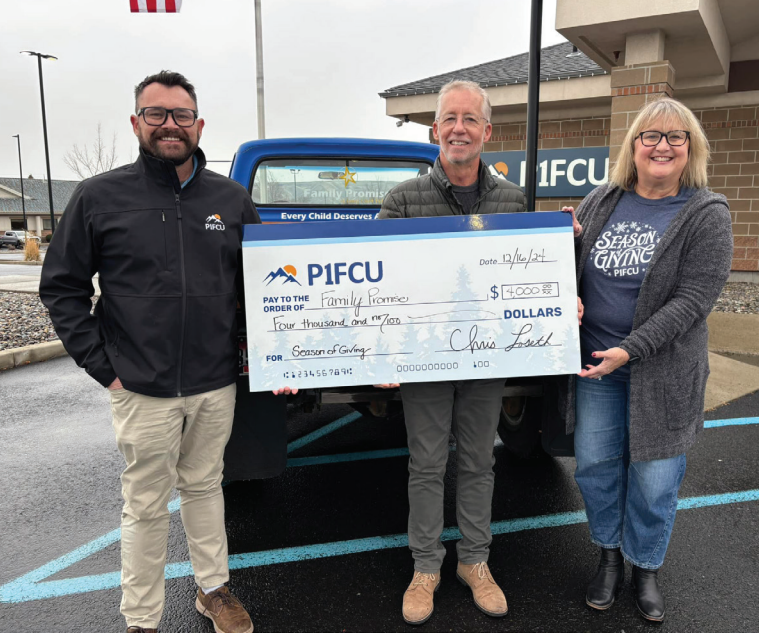
