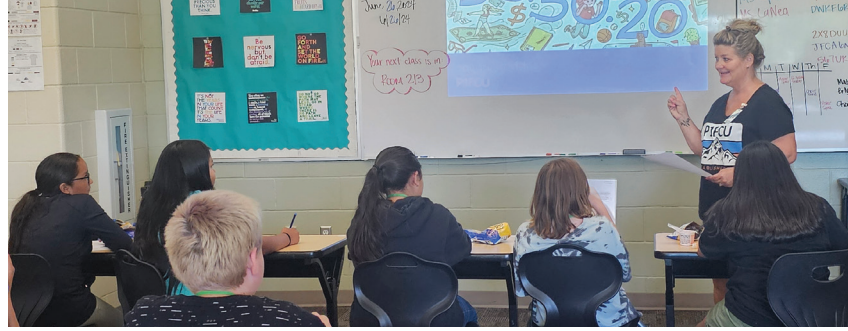
Twin County United Way Golf Invitational

We had a great time sponsoring and supporting the Boys and Girls Clubs of the LC Valley's Keys for Kids Dueling Pianos event.

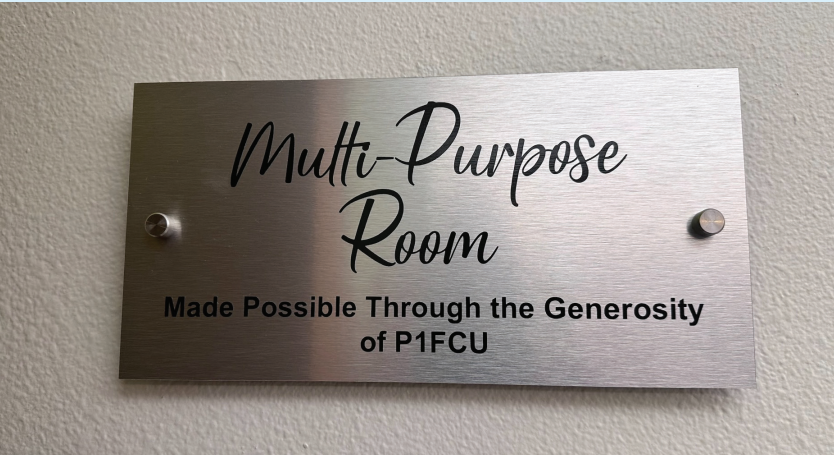


Orofino Maniac Dam Race
