SOUPport Our Shelters is the YWCA's biggest fundraiser of the year, and we were proud to be part of it once again as the delivery sponsor!

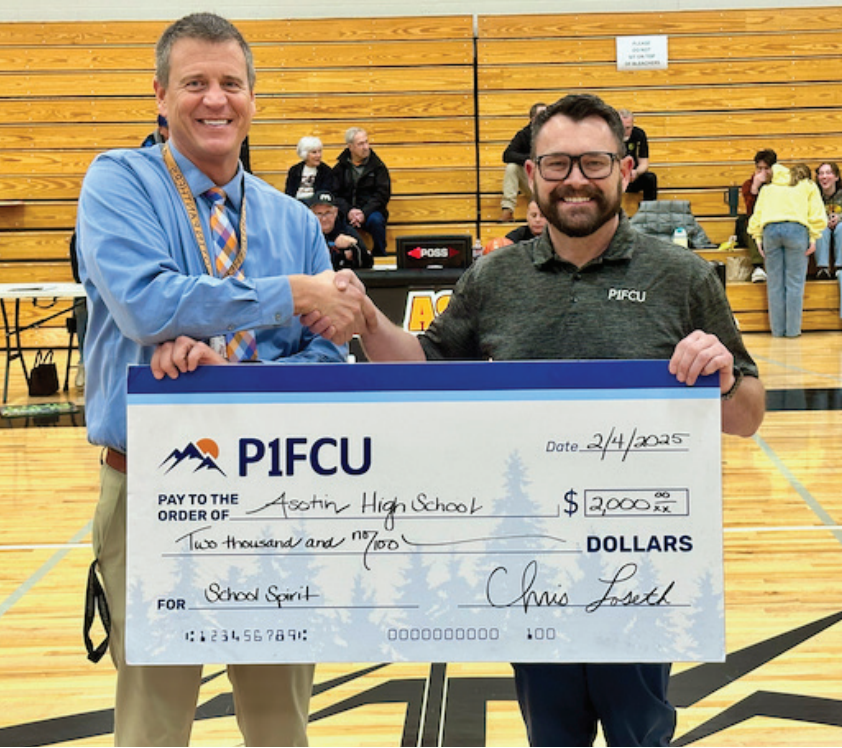

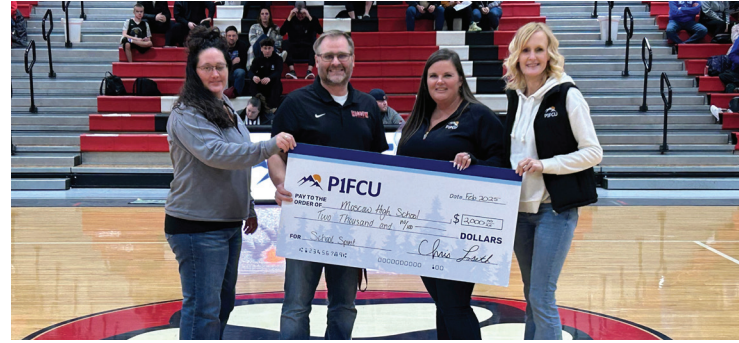

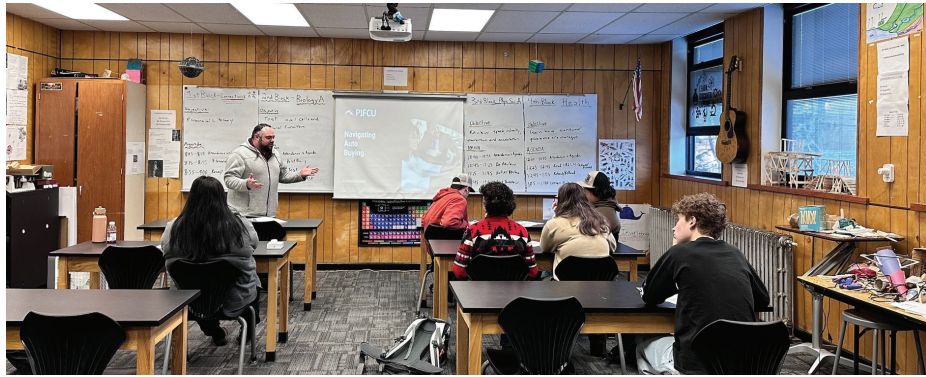


Financial Literacy Class
